

The INSUPPORT™ Copay Assistance Program for SUBLOCADE™ (buprenorphine extended-release) Injection, for Subcutaneous Use (CIII) May Help Eligible Patients Reduce Their Copay

Do you have a patient with private insurance who needs help paying for their medication?

The INSUPPORT™ Copay Assistance Program for SUBLOCADE may help eligible patients pay as little as \$5 per injection of SUBLOCADE.^a

WARNING: RISK OF SERIOUS HARM OR DEATH WITH INTRAVENOUS ADMINISTRATION; SUBLOCADE RISK EVALUATION AND MITIGATION STRATEGY

- **Serious harm or death could result if administered intravenously. SUBLOCADE forms a solid mass upon contact with body fluids and may cause occlusion, local tissue damage, and thrombo-embolic events, including life threatening pulmonary emboli, if administered intravenously.**
- **Because of the risk of serious harm or death that could result from intravenous self-administration, SUBLOCADE is only available through a restricted program called the SUBLOCADE REMS Program. Healthcare settings and pharmacies that order and dispense SUBLOCADE must be certified in this program and comply with the REMS requirements.**

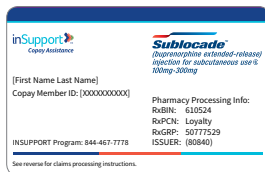

THE INSUPPORT™ COPAY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM MAY HELP ELIGIBLE PATIENTS WITH THEIR COPAY FOR SUBLOCADE (buprenorphine extended-release)

The INSUPPORT™ Copay Assistance Program may help eligible patients being treated with SUBLOCADE reduce their out-of-pocket costs. For Program Terms & Conditions visit insupport.com or see insert in pocket.



Here's how the program works:

- 1 Eligible patients may pay as little as \$5 per injection of SUBLOCADE for the first 2 injections in each calendar year^{a,b}
- 2 After that, eligible patients may receive a maximum of \$800 in copay assistance for the remainder of the calendar year
- 3 If the patient's financial responsibility is greater than the maximum benefit per injection, they will be responsible for any remaining costs not covered by the Program
- 4 The Program benefit is valid for out-of-pocket costs for SUBLOCADE only. It is not valid for any other out-of-pocket costs, including costs associated with the administration of SUBLOCADE (for example, office visit or medication administration charges)
- 5 The Copay Assistance Program and the benefit may change each year



INSUPPORT™ may help provide information on a patient's insurance coverage for SUBLOCADE, if requested.

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WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Does Your Patient Meet These Criteria?

- Private insurance member not covered by a government-funded plan
- Insurance plan that permits coupons or copay assistance for SUBLOCADE
- Coverage provided for some portion of the cost of SUBLOCADE under a medical or pharmacy benefit plan
- Resident of a state where copay assistance is not prohibited
- 18 years of age or older, but under age 65
- Resident of the United States or a U.S. territory
- SUBLOCADE is prescribed for an FDA-approved indication

If so, your patient may be eligible for the Copay Assistance Program. There may be other requirements not listed here. Review the back cover of this brochure to learn how to enroll patients.



If your patient does not meet the requirements, help may be available from other sources.

^a The INSUPPORT™ Copay Assistance Program is valid ONLY for patients with private insurance who are prescribed SUBLOCADE for on-label use. Patients with government insurance are not eligible for the Copay Assistance Program, including, but not limited to, Medicare, Medicaid, Medigap, VA, DoD, TRICARE, CHAMPVA, or any other federally or state-funded government-assisted program. Eligible patients may get started in the INSUPPORT™ Copay Assistance Program for SUBLOCADE in 2 ways:

1. Web Enrollment

You may enroll an eligible patient during an in office appointment by going to www.insupportcopay.com. Please ensure both provider and patient read the Terms and Conditions for the Program and provide the required electronic signature and date.

2. Patient Enrollment Form
