

TRANSITION OF CARE SUPPORT For Patients and Caregivers

INSUPPORT® is here to provide information on the access process on behalf of people seeking treatment with PERSERIS® (risperidone) for extended-release injectable suspension. If you are transitioning to a new provider to continue your treatment with PERSERIS, INSUPPORT can provide you and your new treatment provider with information to support the next steps in your treatment journey. Locate a Community Provider

The first step in planning your transition of care is identifying a provider or facility in your community that can provide you treatment with PERSERIS. Available resources include, but are not limited to, the provider locator listed below.



To find a facility near you that can provide mental health treatment specific to your individual criteria (such as your type of insurance or preferred medication), you can visit the Behavioral Health Treatment Services Locator provided by the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA).

When selecting a new provider, it is important to identify one that can meet your healthcare needs. Consider confirming these key pieces of information:

- The provider/facility offers treatment with PERSERIS
- The provider accepts your health insurance
- The provider is accepting new patients
- You can secure an appointment with the provider by your next injection due date
- The provider is able to administer the injection

For patients enrolled in Transition of Care Support, INSUPPORT can help confirm that the provider you've selected meets these important requirements.

What is the most important information I should know about PERSERIS?

Drugs like PERSERIS that are used to treat schizophrenia can cause serious side effects, including an increased risk of death in elderly people who are confused, have memory loss, and have lost touch with reality (dementia-related psychosis). PERSERIS is not approved to treat dementia-related psychosis and it has not been studied in elderly people with dementia-related psychosis.

Request Support



INSUPPORT can help support a successful transition to your new provider. You may work with your current provider to enroll in Transition of Care Support to:

- understand your insurance benefits for PERSERIS at your new site of care; and/or
- receive text reminders regarding your initial next injection due date or appointment with the new provider. If you opt-in, you will receive a text confirming this request shortly after enrollment. It is important to reply to this text to confirm that you want to receive text reminders from INSUPPORT.
- identify a facility that is able and willing to administer an injection

Understand Next Steps



Prior to leaving your current healthcare setting, remember to obtain contact information for your new provider and your appointment date and time, if scheduled. At a minimum, it is important to know your next injection due date to maintain uninterrupted PERSERIS treatment.

Remember Your First Appointment



If you opted in during the enrollment process, you will receive a text reminder 3 calendar days prior to your next injection due date or your first appointment with your new provider.

Begin Treatment with Your New Provider



Once you have received your initial injection of PERSERIS from your new provider, it is important to maintain your monthly injection schedule. INSUPPORT can provide information about potential options for financial assistance that may be able to help you with the cost of PERSERIS, if applicable.



As you continue treatment, INSUPPORT can support you and your new provider with information on the access process for PERSERIS.
